
BATH "POP-UP" WASTE



- 1) Fit Sponge Seal(5) to Waste Grating(4)
- 2) Insert Waste Grating(4) into hole in bath from upper side
- Fit Rubber Seal(6) to Waste Body(9) and offer Waste Body(9) to underside of bath.
- Secure Grating(4) to Waste Body(9) by means of Fixing Screw(3)
 not tighten firmly at this stage
- 5) Fit 2nd.Rubber Seal(6) to Overflow Head(9c) and offer this assembly to back of overflow opening, ensuring they are centrally positioned and then screw Overflow Face(12) on to central spindle. Ensure Control Cable(9b) is not twisted before fully tightening Overflow Face(12)
- 6) Centralise Grating(4) with Waste Body(9) by lining up ribs of each directly in line and tighten Fixing Screw(3) with a coin or suitable screwdiver. Do not overtighten - handtight plus 1/4 turn should be sufficient.
- Adjust Plug(1) by twisting Control Knob(10) to the 'up' position and then fix Plug height by use of Adjusting Screw(2)
- 8) Secure-Flexible Pipe(13) by tightening Compression Nut(8) against Compression Seal(7)
- 1...Plug
- 2...Adjusting Screw
- 3...Centre Fixing Screw
- 4...Waste Grating
- 5...Sponge Seal
- 6...Rubber Seal
- 7...Plastic Compression Seal
- 8...Compression Nut
- 9...Waste Body
- 9a..Overflow Head
- 9b..Control Cable
- 10..Control Knob
- 11..Locking Screw for 10
- 12.. Overflow Face
- 13..Flexible Pipe
- 14..Rubber Seal
